DON'TS

- Candidates who have previously appeared in any IBA Aptitude test or planning to appear in Round 1 Fall 2026 Admission Cycle will not be eligible.
- Incomplete application forms and documents will not be eligible.
- Candidates who have previously appeared in any orientation program by any university or NGO will not be eligible.
