

IBA NATIONAL TALENT HUNT PROGRAM ACTIVITY REPORT -ORIENTATION PROGRAM- BATCH 2014

On May 16, 2014, students belonging from Sindh, Punjab, Khyber Pakhtunkhawa, Gilgit Baltistan, Balochistan provinces have joined the NTHP Orientation Program —Batch 2014. The training classes commenced on May 17, 2014 and ended on June 21, 2014. We taught them English Grammar & Composition, Mathematics and Presentation & Communication Skills during the one month orientation program. During the orientation classes, IBA's CED Entrepreneurship conducted a 15-hour Workshop on Entrepreneurship for the students of the NTHP program. During this workshop students were introduced to the concept of Entrepreneurship and on how can it be beneficial for the economy of Pakistan. We have also encouraged them to visit the IBA Cowasjee Writing Center to improve their writing skills which is also necessary for the aptitude test.
