INTRODUCTION

The IBA Ihsan Trust National Talent Hunt Program (IBA-IT NTHP) is a fully funded **ORIENTATION TRAINING PROGRAM** jointly financed by IHSAN TRUST and IBA Karachi which selects, grooms and prepare talented students from Balochistan, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa & FATA, Gilgit Baltistan, Punjab, Sindh and Azad Kashmir for the comprehensive admission process of BBA and BS degree programs in IBA Karachi. **The Program is based on merit cum need consideration.** The orientation training emphasizes on academic as well as personal grooming and development and imparts skill set required for higher education.

Ihsan Trust is a non-profit organization, established with the aim of providing financial assistance for various community building services and above all, Qarz e Hasna (Interest-free Loan) facility to the needy students seeking higher education in Pakistan.



ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

HSSC Level- I Students:

Students who have been promoted from HSSC – I to HSSC-II without exams as per government policy can apply provided that they have secured **70% or above** marks in their matriculation exams conducted by the Board of Secondary Education of Pakistan in the year 2019 and will be appearing for HSSC-II examinations in the **year 2021**.

HSSC Level- II Students:

Students who have been promoted based on their HSSC- I result can apply provided that they have awarded **70% or above** marks in their aggregate HSSC-I & II results announced by the Board of Secondary Education of Pakistan in the **year 2020**.

ASSESSMENT TEST & INTERVIEW

Shortlisted candidates will be called for MCQS test, based on Matriculation & HSSC-I curriculum of English Grammar & Composition and Mathematics. Based on Performance of test & other criteria, candidates will be further shortlisted for Panel Interview.

Suggested topics mentioned in the syllabus are for guidance purpose, but the test is not necessarily limited to these:

English Grammar & Composition

- Vocabulary
- Sentence correction & sentence Completion
- Errors Identification
- Reading comprehension & Cloze Passages
- Grammatical concepts
- Tenses and Modal verbs
- Verbs, Articles and Prepositions
- Subject-verb agreement
- Use correct sentence modifiers, such as adjectives, adjective clauses, adverbs, adverb clauses etc.
- Coordinating and subordinating conjunctions and clauses
- Punctuations

Mathematics

- Sets and Number Systems
- Factorization, Exponents and Expressions
- Equations and Inequalities
- Algebraic representation, Sentences & manipulation
- Quadratic Equations
- Decimal Fractions and Percentages
- Ratio, proportion, rate and variations
- Sequences and Series
- Matrices and Determinants
- Roots and Rules of Logarithms
- Plane, solid and coordinate Geometry
- Permutation, Combination and Probability
- Trigonometry
- Functions, Graphs and transformation of graphs
- Word problems (Age, coin, work and mixture problems)

PROGRAM OUTLINE:

1. Those who has followed the due process of selection in the program and have expressed an interest in pursuing higher studies in Business Administration, Computer Science, Accounting & Finance, Economics & Mathematics and Social Sciences & Liberal Arts will be invited to participate in a **two months training program** at IBA Karachi for preparation of admission into BBA and BS degree programs.
2. Selected students for orientation training program will be provided free of cost training, boarding & Lodging, Stipend and study material and one side average train/bus ticket.
3. Training of following subjects & skills will be provided during orientation;

English Grammar & Composition

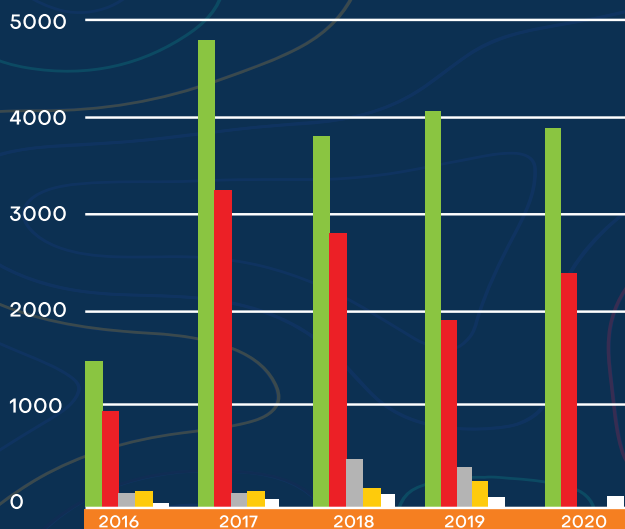

4. The orientation training will be conducted by selected IBA faculty, mentors and other trainers who have demonstrated their proven abilities in their respective fields.
5. Upon completion of orientation training all the trainees will have to appear in IBA aptitude test for BBA/BS degree programs.
6. Those selected on merit and offered admission into BBA, BS (Accounting & Finance), BS (Social Sciences & Liberal Arts), BS Economics, BS (Computer Sciences) and BS (Economics & Mathematics) degree programs will be considered for up to 100 % scholarship/arrangements of Qarz-e-Hasna against tuition fees & other facilities depending upon the need assessment of the student for the mentioned 4-year degree programs on the recommendation of IBA – Financial Aid Committee. **Summer semester is not covered in IBA-IT NTHP.**

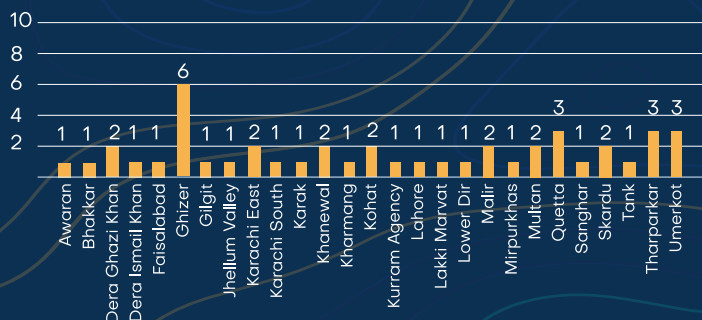
